




The Event






Fisherman's Village





Good to know

Both events are hosted in Reykjavik due to the traffic jams that will form on the day.

It is not advisable at all to drive around outside of Reykjavík a day prior the event. Therefore, we have worked around logistics of the event for clients to be in Reykjavík between Aug 11-13th. Heavy traffic jams are expected all over.

If staying outside of the capital, 2 nights at the same accommodation is advised.

It is good to note that this is a natural event. Visibility is only affected if it rains on the day.
